Be the first player to cover one whole row or column.

Starting the Game:

Knock out each of the 22 letter chips and place them in the drawstring bag. Each player should take one bingo board and some red chips.

Choose one of the players to be the "caller." The "caller" will pull one letter chip at a time out of the drawstring bag and announce that letter out loud. The "caller" can also play if desired.

Playing the Game:

The "caller" reaches into the bag and pulls out a letter chip. The caller announces the letter to the players and whoever has that letter on their board covers that letter with a chip.

Winning the Game:

Be the first player to fill one entire row or column with chips. You are the winner!

If you have fun, then you win!!

Black-out Bingo

Be the first player to cover every space with chips and win the game!

Picture-Frame Bingo:

Be the first player to cover all of the outside spaces to win the game!

Working Together Bingo:

Everyone plays on just one board. When the board is completely covered, everyone wins!

We All Win Bingo:

Each player continues to play until each player finishes one row or column.

Letter Bingo:

The caller doesn't show the letter or the picture on the back. The caller only says which letter it is. No looking!

Picture Bingo:

The caller shows only the picture on the back of the card but doesn't say which letter it is.
