## What is Chanukah Find It First?

Chanukah Find It Firt is a card game consisting of 55 cards, each decorated with Jewish symbols. There are 57 symbols and one and only one matching symbol exists between any two Chanukah Find It game cards!




Sounds interesting and intriguing huh? Stop reading and start playing!!! On the Instruction cards are 3 ways to play Chanukah Find It First.

## GAME #3

**Playing:** Place all the cards face down in a pile in the center.

Designate a "dealer" (which can be one of theplayers). Let the dealer turn over the first 9 cards. Then at the same time, all players try to fina a matching symbol on any 3 cards. The same symbol must be present on all 3 cards. When you spot a matching symbol call it out (example: "shofar!").

Take the 3 cards you have won and let the dealer replace those cards to the middle. When there are fewer than 9 cards left in the game and no more matching cards, the game ends. **Winning:** The player with the most cards wins.



## **GAME #1**

Playing: This is the easiest way to play Chanukah Find It First -Get aquainted with this and then move on to the more advanced games.

Mix the cards, and designate a dealer.
(It can be one of the players)

Let the dealer put out 2 cards at a time in the middle for all the players to see. The first player to spot the match calls it out tad takes the cards.

Winning: The player with the most cards at the end wins.





## GAME #2

**Playing:** Shuffle the cards and deal one card face down to each player.

Place the remaining cards face up in the middle of the table to form a draw pile. At the same time, players flip over their card and the center card.

The first player to see his match calls it out (example: "latkes"), That player takes the center card and places it face up on top of his flipped card building a personal pile.

Now use the new top card on your personal pile to find a match with the center card.

Repeat this until no cards remain in the center.

Winning: The player with the most cards wins.
