



## Object of the game

Score the most points by completing bagel sandwiches — with bonus points for making the biggest sandwich of all!


## Playing the game

Shuffle all the cards and place them, face down, on a flat surface to make a 6 x 8 grid.

The youngest player goes first.

To successfully build a sandwich, player must first flip over a bagel card.

As soon as you turn up a second bagel half, you've got a complete sandwich. A sandwich can be made of just the plain top and bottom bagel halves. Pick up all the cards and put them in a stack in front of you. Your turn is over.

The other PDF files are for the box and the instruction booklet

If you turn over the manhole cover, the life preserver, the tire or the CD, your sandwich is no good. Turn the cards back over —your turn is done!



## Scoring points and winning

The game ends as soon as 10 bagel sandwiches have been completed. Each player scores one point for every sandwich he/she has made.

In addition, the player who has built the biggest bagel gets three bonus points. If there is a tie for the biggest bagel, all players who have the biggest sandwich get one extra point.

The player with the most points wins the game!
